License Proposal Crossing North Coast Railroad Authority (NCRA) Owned Property

### Greetings:

Outlined below is a proposal for the City of Ukiah to obtain three (3) subgrade utility (pipe) Crossing License agreements from NCRA located as described in the Licensed Premises:

#### PROPOSAL:

Licensed Premises:

- (P-01) One subgrade 2" water pipe crossing inside an 8" steel casing, within a 10'x80' Corridor approximately 6'-10' below the bottom of the track bed at Milepost 111.14+/-.
- (P-28) One subgrade 8" water pipe crossing inside a 16" steel casing, within a 10'x80' corridor approximately 6'-10' below the bottom of the track bed at Milepost 110.87+/-.
- (P-29) One subgrade 2" water pipe inside an 8" steel casing, crossing within a 10'x80' corridor approximately 6'-10' below the bottom of the track bed at Milepost 110.69+/-.

Term:

Initial license term of five (10) years automatically renewing after the initial term, for successive five (5) year term intervals unless rail services resume in the vicinity of the identified occupancy. At that time, the crossing will be reviewed for compatibility with the rail operations and crossing modification or termination instructions will be provided as needed with a 180 day notification provided.

Effective Term Date:

15 December 2017

Annual Fee:

Six Thousand Dollars per year (\$6000) due upon license execution. Annual fee will be increased annually by 3% as prescribed by NCRA's approved fee schedule.

Purpose:

Utility (Water Pipe Crossings 3 each)

Termination:

Upon the occurrence of one of the following events:

- Initial license term of ten (10) years automatically renewing after the initial term, for successive five (5) year term intervals.
- Rail services in the vicinity of the occupancy resume. Upon notification thereof and the crossing being deemed incompatible for use with the rail

operations, a 180 day notification for termination will be provided.

Application Fee:

\$1,000, payable upon application to license – see attached application form.

Additional engineering review fees, as determined by NCRA, may be incurred to

evaluate plans & physical improvements made to the licensed area.

Permitting:

The licensee is responsible for permitting & complying with applicable

ordinances.

Note 1:

Right of Entry into NCRA's Right of Way in the vicinity of the 3 crossing locations for construction will be granted to the licensee and licensed contractor(s) not to exceed one (1) year. Right of Entry Fee is \$1,000 payable upon license execution.

Note 2:

The License Agreement is subject to final approval by NCRA. The proposed terms

of the transaction set forth herein are non-binding and subject to change

## REAL ESTATE USE INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

### Licensee's Insurance

Licensee shall, at its sole cost and expense, procure and maintain during the lift of this Lease (except as otherwise provided in the

Licensee will throughout the Term and any Renewal Terms (and any other period when Licensee is in possession of the Licensed Premises) carry and maintain, at its sole cost and expense, the following types of insurance, which shall provide coverage on an occurrence basis, with respect to the Licensed Premises, in the amounts specified with deductible amounts reasonably satisfactory to North Coast Railroad Authority (hereafter "NCRA"):

- (1) <u>Commercial General Liability Insurance</u>: Minimum limits of:
- \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence
- \$2,000,000.00 general aggregate
- North Coast Railroad Authority named as additional insured
- A.M Best's rating of A-, Class IX, or otherwise approved in advance
- (2) \* Comprehensive Automobile Liability Insurance minimum limits of.
- \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence for bodily injury,
- \$500,000.00 per person
- \$100,000.00 property damage
- or a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 for both owned and non-owned vehicles.
- North Coast Railroad Authority named as additional insured
- A.M Best's rating of A-, Class IX, or otherwise approved in advance
- \*Required if Company owned/Licensed vehicles access Licensed premises
- (3) <u>Excess Liability Insurance</u>. Licensee shall also carry and maintain umbrella liability insurance with a limit of not less than \$4,000,000.00 per occurrence.
- (4) \*\* Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability Insurance. Limits no less than:
  - \$500,000 each employee
  - \$500,000 each accident
  - \$1,000,000 policy limit
  - A.M Best's rating of A-, Class IX, or otherwise approved in advance
- \*\* Waived for an individual with no employees or business/corporation not required by State Law to carry coverage.
