SB 1029 (McGuire) has recently been signed into law and will take effect January 1, 2019.

This bill requires the Transportation Agency and the Resources Agency to conduct an assessment to determine the most appropriate way to dissolve the North Coast Railroad Authority (NCRA) and to dispense with its assets and liabilities. Under the bill, this assessment and report back to the legislature is to be completed before July 1, 2020.

Accordingly, NCRA has directed its Executive Director to cooperate fully with this assessment and to provide access to any and all records requested by the state agencies.
