Service Name: Ukiah Mowing in Railroad Corridor- 2025

The Great Redwood Trail Agency is seeking quotes from qualified vendors to provide mowing of grass and other vegetation in the railroad right-of-way between Brush Street and Kunzler Ranch Road north of Ukiah, CA. This RFQ outlines the requirements and submission process for quotes.


Description of Services

Service: Ukiah Mowing in Railroad Corridor-2025

Scope of Work:

- Mowing of grass and other vegetation, as well as garbage removal to allow for mowing, in railroad right-of-way between Brush Street and Kunzler Ranch Road north of City of Ukiah. Approximately 2.07 mile stretch of railroad corridor.
- Mowing does not include Himalayan blackberry bushes.
- Efforts will be made to mow around native California Poppies in the area.
- Garbage removal does not include active encampment materials.
- Proper disposal of removed materials in compliance with California State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) and Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) regulations under Division 2, Title 27.
- Fire prevention measures will be taken:
 - Fire extinguishers and fire suppression tools/equipment will be on site while work is performed. This includes a water truck with an operator.
 - Work will be performed outside of the hottest part of the day
 - o Work will be performed based on the CalFIRE risk assessment classification

Service Location: Railroad Right-of-Way from Brush Street to Kunzler Ranch Road, north of Ukiah, CA.

Timeline: Mowing must be completed no later than June 30, 2025

Prevailing Wage: No

Submission Requirements

Vendors must include the following in their quote:

1. Company Information:

- Name, address, and contact information.
- Company experience with fire prevention protocols.

2. Pricing:

- Itemized cost breakdown.
- Total cost, including any applicable taxes or fees.

3. Service Timeline:

• Estimated start and completion date.

4. Compliance:

 Proof of licensing, insurance, and ability to comply with environmental regulations.

5. Changes to Agreement:

• Please note if there will be any changes needed to GRTA's posted "Sample Agreement for Professional Services."

<u>Insurance Requirements:</u> GRTA requires applicant, contractor(s), and subcontractors to hold \$2 million unrestricted liability insurance. GRTA must receive and approve a certificate naming GRTA as an additional insured party, for <u>all</u> parties involved in the work <u>before</u> work can begin.
